Work Plan of the EUROSAI Task Force on the Audit of Funds Allocated to Disasters and Catastrophes for 2009-2011

This Work Plan sets out the Strategic Goals and proposed activities of the EUROSAI Task Force on the Audit of Funds Allocated to Disasters and Catastrophes (hereinafter referred to as the EUROSAI Task Force) for the period from 2009 to 2011 according to its Terms of Reference.

Strategic Goals

While focusing mainly on auditing the preparedness of appropriate institutions to mitigate the consequences of disasters and catastrophes, the following Strategic Goals were developed:

- 1. Surveying the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes, the funds allocated thereto and the relevant audits, and contributing to audits, in particular concurrent or coordinated audits, by European SAIs.
- 2. Developing the methodology and capacity building of SAIs in the field of auditing the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes.
- 3. Enhancing the collaboration and setting up new contacts between SAIs within the framework of the EUROSAI Task Force activities, facilitating the information sharing between European SAIs and training.
- 4. Developing a common approach and coordination of the efforts with the INTOSAI and EUROSAI working bodies, as well as other international organizations.

Expected results:

- 1. Creation of a database of the audits of natural and man-caused disasters in Europe.
- 2. Development of the glossary of terms on auditing the funds allocated for the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes.
- 3. Conduction of the audit of the funds allocated for the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes.
- 4. Elaboration of the recommendations (guidelines) for the SAIs which carry out audits of the funds allocated for the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes based on obtained and summarized SAIs' experience.

Strategic Goal 1: Surveying and Contributing to Audits

Goal

Surveying the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes, the funds allocated thereto and the relevant audits, and contributing to audits, in particular concurrent or coordinated audits, by European SAIs.

Rationale

European SAIs monitor, subject to their national audit mandate and audit programme, the occurrence of disasters and catastrophes and their consequences elimination.

The practice shows that auditing the disasters and catastrophes by SAIs proved to be a powerful tool for enhancing the control and monitoring of these negative phenomena at the national level as well as for the determining of bottleneck in the management and raising the level of social, economic and ecological safety in the countries.

However, as of today only a few SAIs have carried out the audits of prevention of disasters and catastrophes, including performance audit of the existing national disasterpreventive systems and introduced preventive measures.

Thus, among other things, the question of disasters and catastrophes prevention will also be in the EUROSAI Task Force's special focus.

For this purpose the EUROSAI Task Force plans to commence its work with conducting the questionnaire among EUROSAI and collecting the information on large-scale natural and man-caused disasters in Europe, their nature and classification, flows of international aid, major donors and recipients, measures taken by the governments of the affected countries and identified risks. Additionally, the EUROSAI Task Force will be interested in the lessons learned, examples of best practice and risk areas that were established before by SAIs while auditing the disasters and catastrophes. This will enable to determine perspective topics for collaboration on the issues that are the most pressing and pose the greatest interest for the majority of interviewed SAIs.

The audit of the funds allocated for the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes based on the questionnaire findings will finalize the activities under the given Goal.

Strategic Goal 2: Methodology Development and Capacity Building

Goal

Developing the methodology and capacity building of SAIs in the field of auditing the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes.

Rationale

In order to facilitate capacity building of SAIs in the field of the prevention and elimination of disasters and catastrophes and as based on existing documents of international disaster reduction and INTOSAI bodies and on the results of the questionnaire and the audit of the funds allocated for the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes, the EUROSAI Task Force is going to make a relevant glossary of terms and develop recommendations (guidelines) for SAIs to carry out subject audits. Moreover, the EUROSAI Task Force deems it appropriate to summarize the examples of best practice obtained during the audit. Within the framework of its Strategic Goal 2 the EUROSAI Task Force plans to actively involve external experts that primarily focus on the issues of prevention, occurrence and elimination of natural and man-caused disasters and catastrophes.

Strategic Goal 3: Setting up new contacts and information sharing between European SAIs

Goal

Enhancing the collaboration and setting up new contacts between SAIs within the framework of the EUROSAI Task Force activities, facilitating the information sharing between European SAIs and training.

Rationale

EUROSAI Task Force aims at establishing the efficient dialogue and collaboration between interested SAIs as based on the principles of mutual respect, trust, equality and mutually beneficial cooperation and as guided by the INTOSAI goals and values.

EUROSAI Task Force will endeavour to facilitate during its meetings the establishment and development of bilateral relations between interested SAIs that express mutual intention to enhance the efficiency of their activities in particular the audit of funds allocated to disasters and catastrophes and related audits. EUROSAI Task Force will seek to organize bilateral meetings within the framework of its sessions and

promote the exchange of printed and electronic materials developed on the results of audits conducted by SAIs. During its mandate period the EUROSAI Task Force will inform on regular basis on the results of its activities in the INTOSAI and EUROSAI printed and electronic editions (INTOSAI Journal, INTOSAI WGEA Greenlines, EUROSAI Newsletter etc), as well as permanently report on the progress made to the EUROSAI Governing Board.

Additionally, it is planned to introduce on continuing basis the exchange of experience between interested SAIs through, in particular, information sharing and training activities during the EUROSAI Task Force meetings, as well as running a separate web-page on the EUROSAI Task Force at the web-site of the Accounting Chamber of Ukraine.

Strategic Goal 4: Cooperation with International Organisations

Goal

Developing a common approach and coordination of the efforts with the INTOSAI and EUROSAI working bodies, as well as other international organisations.

Rationale

The predecessor of the EUROSAI Task Force, the EUROSAI WGEA Special Subgroup on the Audit of Natural, Man-caused Disasters Consequences and Radioactive Wastes Elimination established and developed collaboration with INTOSAI and EUROSAI working bodies responsible for the environmental auditing and disaster-related aid.

EUROSAI Task Force intends to continue cooperation in this field, and, particularly, with the INTOSAI and EUROSAI Working Groups on Environmental Auditing and the INTOSAI Working Group on Accountability for and the Audit of Disaster-related Aid in terms of further promoting the consolidation of efforts of the international SAI community to contribute to preserving safe environment for the people in Europe, exchanging work plans, audit plans, methodology and findings in the field of environmental auditing and the auditing of disaster-related aid, as well as developing guidelines and recommendations on the audits of the prevention of disasters and catastrophes.

EUROSAI Task Force plans to draw external expertise from international, and in particular European, institutions and organisations dealing with the issues of ecological safety and environmental protection, especially in the field of the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes.
